- **Entry Deadlines** (12:00 PM ET the Wednesday before each meet):
  - December 4th for the Early Bird Invite
  - January 15th for the Collegiate Showdown
  - February 12th for the Hydraulic Highway Invite

## ATHLETES ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE

- NCAA Division I, II & III Eligible Collegiate Athletes.
- Unattached, redshirt, or post-collegiate athletes
- **NO NJCAA or NIAA Schools**
- **NO HS TEAMS**

## ENTRY PROCEDURE:

- Entries must be submitted online via **DirectAthletics**.
- It is not the responsibility of The TRACK at New Balance staff to complete team entries.
- Double-check all entries with **TFRRS**.
- Collegiate coaches may only enter eligible NCAA athletes; others must use individual entries.
- Final entries will be available at [www.lancertiming.com](http://www.lancertiming.com) 1 day before the meet.

## ENTRY FEE:

- **Collegiate Teams:**
  - \$700 per team per gender (\$1,400 for men's & women's teams)
  - Teams must consist of 12 or more per gender or will be charged an individual fee.
- **Unattached Athletes:**
  - \$45 per athlete per event, payable via credit card on DirectAthletics.
  - All entry marks will be verified; false submissions may be adjusted.
  - All entry fees are just that - an ENTRY fee, not a competition fee. No refunds possible.

## Important Entry Information:

Please read the entry guidelines carefully before submitting your entry.

Note that the fee paid is an **entry fee**, not an acceptance fee. Meeting the minimum entry standard does not guarantee acceptance into the meet.

Entry fees are **non-refundable**. No refunds will be issued for scratches or for entries that are not accepted into the meet. This is specifically for limited events such as the 5,000m and all Throwing events.

## ENTRY MARKS/SEEDING:

- Performances must be verified by **TFRRS**.
- Seed times must be from 2023, 2024, or 2025 TFRRS results.
- Final field sizes will determine starting heights and minimum marks for jumping and throwing events.
- For **Shot Put** and **Weight Throw**, only the top 32 verified marks will be accepted.
- Finalists: Top 8 in field events advance to finals.
- **Shot Put & Weight Throw** (Top 32 verified marks)
- The top 32 verified marks for all throwing events will be verified. A list of accepted athletes will be listed on direct athletics
- All top entry performances will be verified with TFRRS for accuracy. Performances that cannot be verified will be subject to non-acceptance into the meet.

## ADVANCEMENT:

- In all field events that dictate, 8 will advance to the finals
- In the 60m Hurdles, heat #'s will be determined after entries close to determine the advancement to finals.

## EVENTS CONTESTED:

- 60, 60 Hurdles, 200, 400,500m, 600, DMR, 800, 1 mile, 3000, Invitational 5000m, 4x400, Long Jump, Triple Jump, High Jump, Pole Vault, Shot Put (32 Field Size), Weight Throw (32 Field Size)
  - (5000m races TBD based on request)
- December 7<sup>th</sup> - 500m Men's and Women's & Invitational 5000m (Limited Field) to 35 total athletes (2 heats)

## EVENT DAY LOGISTICS:

- **Packet Pick-Up:** Available at the main entrance (91 Guest Street) at the White Table for coaches and media.
- **Results:** Posted at [www.lancertiming.com](http://www.lancertiming.com).
- **Spike Requirements:** 1/4" pyramid spikes only (checked at check-in); no needle or Christmas tree spikes allowed.
- **Facility:** Beynon 200m banked oval, 6-lane track, and 8-lane sprint straight. [View the facility here.](#)
- **Team Drop-Off:** At the main entrance (91 Guest Street). Buses cannot park on the street after drop-off.
- **Practice:** Available by request for the Collegiate Showdown Only (Times TBD).

- Sprint races:200/400/600: 5-6-4-3-2-1

### POLE VAULT POLES:

- The TRACK at new balance does **NOT** accept deliveries so if you plan on sending poles in advance, you **MUST** send them to your team hotel.

### IMPLEMENT WEIGHN IN :

- All throwing implements must be weighed in. Time to be determined.

### SPORTS MEDICINE:

- Team Camps may set up in the middle of the warmup track (Level 4) using vinyl tape only

### SPECTATOR TICKETES:

- \$20.00 (children under 3'6" are free). Ticket link will be provided three weeks before the meet.

### PRESS CREDENTIAL REQUEST:

- Available for pick-up at the 1st floor lobby reception desk. Credentials are required for track-level access.
